What is the First Call service?
The British Red Cross provides time limited support to anyone over the age of 18. We

offer practical and emotional support to enable people to live independently in their own homes this could be someone who has been in hospital or someone in the community who has had an accident, illness or bereavement. The service will help give confidence to continue their daily lives. The service is volunteer lead & donation run. We do not charge for the service but welcome a donation if possible.

The service is designed to help you make choices about your life.

- We can: Help you to plan your return home from hospital assisting you to settle in and feel more confident.
- Visit you at home to help you rebuild your independence.
- Offer you companionship to relieve isolation.
- Help you manage day to day activities such as shopping and paperwork.
- Help you broaden your social activities.
- Provide information and advice on how to access other services.

Assist you to increase safety and security at home. Deliver medication and small items of equipment.

at home to maintain their independence.

What's ongoing at present in the Parish?

Well, as you will have seen in the press the more detailed plans for the **Southern Quadrant** that we expected to be with SKDC last year finally arrived and were debated at Development meeting in July! We were able to have our say and we feel this was quite successful, as both the Planners and the Developers stated that they wanted to work with us to get the best results for all concerned. We still hope you the parishioners will keep us informed of your thoughts.

We have just heard that the planning appeal for Somerby Hill was unsuccessful, we are still waiting for the result of the Harrowby Hill planning application. We will let you know of any further developments as we get them. We do know though that both these pieces of land are missing from the next District Plan, now being discussed by SKDC.

Over the last few months we have had some trouble with "Travellers" illegally setting up camps within the Parish, please let us and the Police know about anything you see as soon as possible.

We mentioned last year about wanting to enhance all play areas over time and not knowing what would happen about the Bridge End Grove site. We have discovered that within the developers plans they say they will be upgrading it. We will keep them to that.

The Parish councillors are keen to improve the parish for all residents. To do this we need to be aware of any problems that arise. Some people are very good and report problems as they occur but we would also like your ideas on what we could do in certain areas to prevent these before they arise.

We would also like to hear of any new projects that could be considered for the future.
